- 1 Martial Couvreur N.V. Brut Cuvée Spéciale** **£45.00**
Full-bodied with rich and creamy fruit aromas, this is elegant and charming with a soft, rounded finish.
- 2 Martial Couvreur N.V. Rosé Champagne** **£50.00**
Made from Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. This lovely pink Champagne is crisp and flavoursome with ample mousse and a lingering finish.
- 3 Pol Roger White Foil** **£60.00**
*Remarkable Champagne with tiny bubbles. Clean fruit on the nose and a delicate mousse with a clean dry flavour on the palate.
A favourite of Sir Winston Churchill and also used at the Royal Wedding of William and Kate.*
- 4 Pol Roger Vintage 2004** **£110.00**
Striking Pinot nose, huge ripeness and complexity, with great weight and richness. It has serious backbone with fine length and smoky spiced concentration.
- 5 Sixteen Ridges Signature Cuvée England** **£42.00**
Made with Pinot Noir and Seyval Blanc, this is vivacious wine with lemon, baked apple, honeysuckle and hazelnut characteristics and an elegant, long, clean finish.
- 6 Prosecco Lunetta** **Italy** **£25.00**
Light and fruity with hints of apple and peach and a fresh, softly sparkling palate.
- 7 Prosecco Lunetta** **Italy 20cl** **£8.50**
A small version of the above: no need to share!
- 8 Spumante Rosado** **Italy 20cl** **£8.50**
Soft rosé with ripe berry flavours balanced with lively fizz and again a bottle all to yourself!

WINE OF THE MONTH

This month the two wines we have chosen are from Chile.



Viña Ravanal

Founded in 1936 by Teodoro Ravanal, Viña Ravanal is one of the oldest wine estates in the Colchagua Valley. The family tradition continues with his son Mario, a leading oenologist and his grandchildren Pia, Carmen Paz and Mario Sebastian who have chosen to follow the same profession with the philosophy of making high quality wine.

The vineyards, located in Placilla and San Jose de Manantiales, surround the family estate and include the invaluable resource of vines of over one hundred years old in their 'Centenary Vineyards'.

The exceptional terroir of the Colchagua Valley produces grapes of outstanding quality, particularly in red wines. Hand harvesting, followed by careful selection, well-judged use of French and American oak and skilful blending transform the grapes into excellent and complex wines.

The Reserva wines define their region and variety, each expressing a complex personality. The Cabernet Sauvignon and Chardonnay stand out due to their body, concentration, character, complexity and maximum fruit expression which integrates beautifully with the oak.

Chardonnay Reserva

*Bright yellow in colour with intense tropical fruit flavours of banana and pineapple, and hints of vanilla and caramel. Aged in American and French oak barrels to provide complexity and elegance.
Perfect with fish, shellfish or chicken.*

Cabernet Sauvignon Reserva

Ruby red wine with aromas of strawberries and ripe plums. Well-structured with elegant, soft, ripe tannins. Aged for 10 months in French and American oak for complexity and refinement. Great with red meat, also good with cheese.

WHITE WINES

9 Sauvignon Blanc **South Africa** **£17.95**
Millberg Cellars

A wonderfully fresh bouquet with ample fruit on the palate and fresh creamy acidity on the finish.

Great with seafood, chicken, pasta or salad.

10 Chardonnay **France** **£18.95**
Domaine de Belle Mare

Delicate nose of flowers, wild mint, honey and white fruits. Elegant and complex, it has a little acidity to give balance and good length on the palate.

Ideal with fish or chicken dishes.

11 Pinot Grigio, Veneto **Italy** **£19.95**
Cantina Danese

The nose is intense with good levels of fruit, notably notes of fresh ripe apricot; the finish is rounded with length.

RED WINES

12 Shiraz Pinotage **South Africa** **£17.95**
Millberg Cellars

Intense black plum and ripe berry flavours with hints of vanilla. Medium bodied with a lingering fruity aftertaste.

Perfect with red meats or game.

13 Merlot **France** **£18.95**
Domaine de Belle Mare

The nose is of soft black fruit, the palate is round with liquorice overtones balanced by silky tannins.

Compliments red meat dishes and soft cheese.

14 Pinot Noir **Italy** **£19.95**
Cantina Danese

Lovely aromas of cherry, blackcurrants and raspberries. Elegant and fruity. Medium bodied with good length on the finish.

ROSÉ

15 Pinotage Rosé **South Africa** **£17.95**

Excellent rosé with depth and a little spice, fruit driven flavours that are fresh and clean; this is just off dry.

16 Pinot Grigio Blush Mirabello, Italy **£19.95**
Adria Vini

Fresh and crammed with summer fruit flavours.

- 17 Chenin Blanc** **South Africa** **£17.95**
Millberg Cellars
Pale in colour with good fruit on the nose and a delicate palate. Well balanced with a fresh and lasting finish.
- 18 Muscat** **France** **£19.95**
Domaine de Belle Mare
Big fruit on the nose leading to a massive mouthful of classic gooseberry and elderflower flavours.
- 19 Picpoul de Pinet, Languedoc** **France** **£23.95**
Domaine de Belle Mare
A classic! Fresh, crisp and dry with great appeal as it is rich and lively with great minerality on the palate, but has kept its clean acidity on the finish. A perfect accompaniment for seafood and shellfish.
- 20 Rioja Blanco** **Spain** **£23.95**
Hacienda López de Haro
Fresh and fruity with ripe melon and pear; lingering vanilla and buttery flavours.
- 21 Verdejo** **Spain** **£26.95**
Palacio de Bornos
Pale yellow in colour with hints of green. Intense floral aromas and crisp acidity with good levels of fruit.
- 22 Macon Loché, Burgundy** **France** **£28.50**
Domaine de la Rouletière
Nose of white flowers, acacia, peach, lemon and quince. Complex, balanced and elegant with a nice minerality and a touch of citrus on the finish. Well matched with white meat or fish.
- 23 Bacchus** **UK** **£29.50**
Sixteen Ridges
Aromas of crushed basil and herbaceous gooseberries and a crisp, clean finish. Superb pairing for fish or chicken dishes.
- 24 Sauvignon Blanc** **New Zealand** **£29.95**
Babich Wines
An inviting mix of gooseberry and tropical, passionfruit aromas. Palate entry is luscious and lively, bursting with passionfruit. The finish is wonderful, with good length and displays that minerality that has put Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc on the map.
- 25 Gavi del Comune di Gavi** **Farigliano, Italy** **£31.50**
Azienda Vitivinicola Patrizi
A gently spicy nose with hints of green apple. Light with hints of lime marmalade and toasty characters.

26 Pouilly Fuissé, Burgundy **France** **£34.95**
Cave des Grands Crus Blancs
Straw colour with a full, flowery bouquet, good length and delicate ripeness. This is a complex style of Chardonnay with nutty characteristics.

27 Chablis Montmain 1er Cru, Burgundy **France** **£39.50**
2010 Jean et Sebastien Dauvissat
This wine has ripe fruit aromas on the nose and intense flavours on the palate, balanced by the typical minerality which made Chablis famous.

28 Sancerre Ultimus, Loire **France** **£39.95**
2011 Domaine Thomas et Fils AOC
The ultimate Sancerre! From old vines grown on clay and limestone, barrel fermented and left on the lees for three months this wine is rich and structured, full bodied, with notes of toast and vanilla and a long finish.

R O S É

29 Alta Rio Rosado, Rioja **Spain** **£26.95**
Consejo de la Alta
An attractive salmon pink colour with an aromatic nose of red fruits and delicate floral and herbal notes. Clean on the palate with a rounded finish.

R E D W I N E S

30 Merlot **South Africa** **£17.95**
Millberg Cellars
Soft fruit with ample body, good length and a touch of tannin on the finish.

31 Château la Commanderie de Queyret **France** **£24.50**
Claude Comin
Classic Bordeaux with deep red fruit aromas followed by good levels of fruit on the palate and a long finish with a twist of tannin. Great with red meat dishes, especially steak.

32 Chianti Colli Fiorentini **Italy** **£26.95**
Guicciardini
85% Sangiovese is augmented with Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon in this Chianti, which offers mature black plum, white pepper and baking spice aromas. The lively palate delivers tart sour cherry, clove and underbrush notes, with a smoothly tannic structure.

33 Barbera di Alba **Italy** **£27.50**
Azienda Agricola Filippino
A deep ruby red colour with fresh, fragrant ripe red fruit. This wine spent 6 months in oak giving a more medium-bodied, easier drinking red wine with a touch of spice. A fantastic alternative for lovers of Pinot Noir.

34 Shiraz Earthworks, Barossa Valley **Australia** **£27.95**
Bitter & La Nauze
Aromas of ripe dark cherries, red fruits and plums with hints of vanilla. Rich juicy palate with flavours of wild blackberries and charming length on the finish.

- 35 **Côtes du Rhône Princes d'Orange** France £28.50
Domaine de Boissan
*Deep in colour with rich aromas on the nose and a long, slightly spicy finish
 Lovely with lamb dishes or other red meats.*
- 36 **Bourgogne Pinot Noir, Burgundy** France £35.00
Domaine Denis
*Classic raspberry Pinot flavours, a good nose and ample fruit add to the subtle
 balance.*
- 37 **Malbec Le Péché du Clos, Cahors** France £35.00
Roussille et Filles
*Bold, spicy and elegant, with nicely blended tannins and lovely aromas of red
 and black fruit.*
- 38 **Château La Picherie, Bordeaux** France £35.00
Montagne St Emilion
Clean cassis aromas on the nose with a full palate and a long finish.
- 39 **Rioja Gran Reserva** Spain £37.50
Cerro Anon
*The nose has a delicate balance of aromas opening with red fruits that melt with
 smoky notes and spices and hints of leather and tobacco. Round, full and soft in
 the mouth, it has a lingering, elegant finish. .*
- 40 **Châteauneuf du Pape, Rhône** France £42.00
Cuvée Papale
*Earthy aromas and spiced black fruit mingle with tar, charcoal, smoke, tobacco
 and pine needles. The palate is velvety and warm; medium/full-bodied.*

2012 Dufourg~Landry
*Rich and elegant! Bio-dynamic wine, aged for 18 months in oak, this is complex,
 warm and pleasing on the palate with a broad mouthfill and long, soft yet chewy
 tannins on the finish.
 Great with red meat dishes, especially steak and strong cheese.*
- 42 **Pavillon de Glana, St. Julien** France £55.00
2009 Société Civile d'Exploitation du Château du Glana
*Beautiful dark colour with young purple-blue tints. Pleasant, fairly elegant nose.
 Black fruit aromas (plums and black cherries) are tinged with oak touches, hints
 of tobacco, earth and mild spices.*

WHISKY

Kavalan Solist ~ Taiwan (Rare) 58% £12.00
Cattle egret in colour, this is a cask strength, delightfully complex, multi-dimensional single malt, with vanilla, tropical fruit and coconut on the nose. The palate has well-balanced natural sweetness, honey, vanilla and peppery, oaky spices and is silky smooth.

Jefferson's Ocean Aged at Sea ~ Bourbon 45% £8.00
Sharp, rich, sweet aromas, starting with a healthy dose of bourbon spice followed by rich caramel and vanilla, dark fruit, orange zest, honey and oak, all of which follow on nicely on the palate.

Willet's Pot Still ~ Bourbon 47% £ 7.00
Hints of vanilla, pine spice and mint on the nose with notes of oak, hay and citrus coming through on the palate. The finish has a mellow, warming pepperiness.

Nikka from the barrel ~ Japan 51% £5.00
Powerful aromas of pear drops, tropical fruits and a lot of green banana, underneath which resides a nice depth of oaky sweetness and a hefty dose of malt. Concentrated and robust, the oakiness is in excellent balance with the fruit, and the cask strength high proof makes it dance on the tongue.

Benromach 10yr old ~ Speyside 43% £4.50
Malt and oak on the nose with some fruit and a touch of spirit. Sweet spices and maple fudge after a time and a hint of prune from the sherry cask. Slightly herbal palate and a bittersweet finish with ginger and dry sherry.

Bruichladdich Classic Laddie ~ Islay 50% £4.50
Single malt, crafted from individually selected casks to showcase the classic, floral and elegant Bruichladdich house style. This is their signature bottling, unpeated and the definitive Bruichladdich. Made from Scottish barley, then matured by the shores of Lochindaal in premium American & Spanish oak.

Tullibardine Burgundy Finish ~ Highland 40% £4.00
Spicy nose, with notes of red berry fruit, vanilla and toasted oak. Creamy, nutty palate with notes of sweet custard, apple peel, red berries and orange blossom honey. The long finish has plum jam and allspice.

Jameson ~ Ireland 40% £3.50
The nose is full and floral with a smooth sweetness. Marmalade and fudge, Madeira and a little cut grass note. The palate is thick and of good body with notes of orchard fruits, both fresh and cooked with a little vanilla cream. The finish is of medium length with spice and honey.

Evan Williams Extra Aged ~ Bourbon 40% £3.50
Caramel apples, spearmint and black pepper on the nose, with a light hint of corn in the background and a slightly spicy kick of clove. The palate has raisins and walnuts, with creamy vanilla at the core and an underpinning hint of vegetal oak and zesty orange oil. The finish is quite spicy, with drying notes of cinnamon bark and pine nuts.

BRANDY / COGNAC / ARMAGNAC

Hine Rare 40% £5.00
A Fine Champagne blend of more than 25 Grande and Petite Champagne cognacs with an average age of approximately 10 years. Rare is Hine's most delicate cognac with acacia and fruity aromas. Well balanced, mellow and delightfully smooth on the palate.

Baron de Sigognac 10 year old 40% £5.00
A fine nose is marked by notes of vanilla, cinnamon and candied orange peel. The palate is rich and round with butterscotch, sweet spice and oak leading to a long and pleasing finish.

Carlos 1 ~ Spain 38% £5.00
The intense dark amber colour is the prelude to an intense bouquet, with aromas of sweet pastry, vanilla and spicy oak. The palate is very elegant, with notes of ripe plums and dates, brown sugar and spice.

LIQUEURS

Grande Dauphine ~ France 40% 25ml £3.50
A maceration of bittersweet oranges, alpine plants from Chartreuse, spices, cognac and sugar, but the exact recipe is a well-guarded secret! Its aromatic complexity is best appreciated if you drink it from a brandy balloon, maybe with some crushed ice.

Baileys ~ Ireland 17% 50ml £3.50
Lush fresh cream, nutty, toasty, nougat aromas and a perfectly balanced dash of Irish Whiskey.

Tia Maria ~ Jamaica (originally) 20% 25ml £3.50
Fresh coffee and enticing caramel on the nose, soft palate, with a slight vanilla sweetness following a whisp of coffee and rum blending together.

Amaretto DiSaronno ~ Italy 28% 25ml £3.30
The nose has a medium-sweet intensity of marzipan, almond extract, cherry and orange which all carry through to the palate with a lingering finish. Please note that no almonds are used in the production of DiSaronno!

Drambuie ~ Scotland 40% 25ml £3.50
Aromas of scotch, honey, raisins, dried figs and apricots, heather, vanilla and spices, all of which carry through to the sweet palate and the deliciously long finish.
